The challenge

The Home Shores cafe windows in the Great War Exhibition required protection from the sun to create a comfortable working environment. The designer wanted to replicate an early 20th century retractable Holland blind. The window had a drop of over 3 metres with an install height of over 5 metres.

The SP solution

A calico-like fabric which allowed light through the fabric, but provided good protection from the sun was used. To eliminate chains which give it a “modern” look, the blinds are automated, using a solar-powered battery motor. This created a clean look of an “old” roller blind and solved the problem of reaching a blind over 5 meters up. A crocheted ring pull completed the desired look.
