### The challenge

The Heartland Bank office at 277 Broadway, Newmarket, was a 2016 Interior Awards finalist in the 'Workplace over 1000 square meters' category. Warren & Mahoney designed the new offices to a brief from Heartland that focused on creating a practical, comfortable working environment. The design focused on a semi-industrial design style, creating an open-plan, inward facing layout of the space with no rooms or cubicles, meaning natural light floods the interior and creates a glare issue.

### The SP solution

Using the dark SP View® Char fabric, we significantly reduced glare while allowing ample natural light to enter, thus creating a comfortable environment. The SP View® range is ideal as it is composed of PVC coated fiberglass, making it durable and stable in very high temperatures. A second Heartland Bank in Teed Street, Newmarket, has a more public front. In this location, a second set of Thermo Block® FR blinds were added to maximise light control.
